Los Angeles River Master Plan Earth Day 2007

On May 3, 2007, at the Wrigley Greenbelt in Long Beach, Supervisor Don Knabe celebrated the Los Angeles River Master Plan Earth Day 2007 with Director of Public Works, Donald Wolfe and 56 students from Jordan High School.



Supervisor Knabe also officiated at the dedication of the Wrigley Greenbelt gate at the Los Angeles River. The gate was partially funded by Proposition A.

The construction of this handsome ornamental gate marks the starting point of the Wrigley Greenbelt Project by the City of Long Beach. The project will enhance the area with landscaping, the planting of native trees and shrubs, a multipurpose decomposed granite

trail, and a rest area for bikers riding along the Los Angeles River on the LARIO Bike Trail. The Department of Public Works maintains many recreational bike trails along the rivers of Los Angeles County.
